Safeguarding: If you or your children have any safeguarding concerns, please remember that our Designated Safeguarding Leads in school are: Mr Hickey, Mr Haywood, & Miss Stoppard.

COVID Update: Since Tuesday 14th December 2021, any children aged 5 to 18 and any fully vaccinated adults, identified as a close contact of someone with Covid19, whether Omicron or not - should take a home lateral flow device (LFD) test every day for 7 days instead of self-isolating.

Adults not fully vaccinated (ie classed as 2 weeks after jab 2, currently) must still self-isolate for 10 days. If your child is identified as a close contact, they should take an LFD test each day for 7 days, ideally in the morning before school, and the result reported through the NHS online reporting system [https:// www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result](https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result)
