Staying Safe at School and Home: Please make sure you maintain social distancing of 2 metres from others at school drop off and pick up times. **DON'T BE A CONTACT!**

Since Wednesday 2nd December Barnsley will be in the **VERY HIGH (TIER 3)**

This means that:

- You must not meet socially indoors or most outdoor places with anybody you do not live with, or who is not within your support bubble, this includes any private garden or at most outdoor venues.
- You must not socialise in a group of more than 6 in some other outdoor public spaces, including parks, countryside accessible to the public, a public garden, or a sports facility - this is called the 'rule of 6'.

Reception places for September 2021: If you have a child born between 1st September 2016 and 31st August 2017, you have from now until 15th January 2021 to apply for a Reception place for September 2021
