#### **ECO Warriors!**

I recently received a report from the local authority showing the power usage that each school in Barnsley has used. Whilst our school was not the worst in terms of total consumption used, I want to improve this significantly. We will be launching an Eco Warrior team of children who will make sure that all stakeholders are educated about the importance of only using power when necessary. #### Keep Our Children Safe

I have received reports from a number of parents concerned about the safety of Sandhill children when playing out in Great Houghton at present on an evening or weekend. Children from other villages as well as children considerably older than our pupils are coming to Great Houghton and displaying anti-social behaviour such as under-age drinking and smoking. Our children have been encouraged to take part in this. Please stay vigilant and report any concerns to the police in order to keep our children safe from harm.

#### **Transition Days**

At the start of the next half term, information regarding transition days will be sent out for our children. Vulnerable children, who require additional transition in order to be fully prepare for the next academic year, will start to receive additional transition by meeting their new teachers and Tas on a regular basis in order to build up positive relationships in preparation for September.

The Transition days for Y6 children moving to their secondary schools have been sent to us. Individual letters for each secondary school will be sent out to Y6 parents so that they can see when that school is completing transition.

I have met with the Netherwood SEND team this week and will be meeting with the Dearne SEND team at the start of next week to discuss additional transition for our vulnerable Y6 children. This information will also be put on their transition letters.

#### Sunny Weather

As the days begin to get warmer, please can you remember to bring water bottles for children along with sun cream, hats and glasses as well as given them hay fever medication if necessary.

## **Healthy Eating**

We are two weeks into our healthy eating campaign supported through school council. Your child should now have received their Heathy Eating Passports - children who present a healthy snack at break or dinner time, will receive a stamp that will earn them healthy rewards. Thank you to everyone that has supported their children so far by encouraging healthier options over chocolate, crisps and other unhealthy choices.
