#### Why is Pupil Voice so Important at Sandhill?

Pupil voice in school means a whole-school commitment to listening to the views, wishes and experiences of all children and young people. It means placing value on what children and young people tell school staff about their experiences.

Children and young people need to be provided with meaningful opportunities to share their experiences, views and hopes about their school. Pupils need to know that it is safe and that it is important for them to express their views on what happens at school. They need to know that what they say is valued and will be listened to and considered.

At Sandhill, we want all pupils to have a voice!

#### **Scooters and Bikes**







Despite the success of last year when children stopped riding their bikes and scooters up and down the hill towards school, our pupils this year have started to do this again; this is dangerous and if we do not take further action, somebody could easily get hurt.

In order to try and prevent further action from being required, we will be re-introducing the system from last year. If your child is caught riding their scooter or bike up or down the hill, the following actions will take place:

Stage 1 - A Verbal Warning (this will be logged in school).

Stage 2 - An Amber Warning (a letter will be sent to parents stating that your child has one more chance to follow our school rules before a ban takes place).

Stage 3 - A Red Warning (a letter will be sent to parents explaining that their child is banned from entering the school grounds on their scooter or bike; any child that continues to bring them will have their belongings placed in school with parents asked to come and collect them).
